May I suggest that in the section dealing with who requires mandatory training you add: - Portable tank operators - Rail tank car operators - Those who fill all kinds of tank In the subject area, these kinds of persons need to be trained in at least: - Pressure containment level requirements for the various kinds of tanks - Pressure relief devices - Closure systems on outlets on tanks - Compatibility of the materials of construction of tank shells, pipework, valves and gasket materials - minimum and maximum permitted degrees of filling as minimum requirements for the training of staff for all kinds of tank with additional requirements for tanks for compressed, liquefied, dissolved and deeply refrigerated liquified gases?
