1. GRANTEE: 21<sup>st</sup> Century Environmental Management, Inc. of RI  
(Former Grantee: Safety-Kleen Services, Inc.)  
Providence, RI

2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:

a. This exemption authorizes the transportation in commerce of Division 2.3 materials on the same transport vehicle with materials classed as Division 2.1, Class 3, Class 4, Class 5, and Class 8, subject to the terms and limitations of this exemption. This exemption provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein.

b. The safety analyses performed in development of this exemption only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce.

3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.

4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 177.848(d) in that the transport of certain hazardous materials with other containerized hazardous materials is not authorized, except as specified herein.

5. BASIS: This exemption is based on the application of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Environmental Management Inc., of RI dated February 2, 2004, submitted in accordance with § 107.109.

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR § 172.101):

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:a. PACKAGING -

(i) The Division 2.3 material must be packaged as required by 49 CFR, Part 173. In addition, each DOT-authorized package of Division 2.3 materials must be placed in a plastic bag which is taped closed and then overpacked in a DOT Specification 1A2 steel or 1H2 plastic drum tested and marked for a Packing Group II or higher performance level. No more than 20 L of Division 2.3 materials are authorized in each package.

(ii) The Division 2.1 material may be packaged in a DOT specification cylinder that does not require a strong outer packaging per § 173.301(a)(9); or if in a cylinder identified in § 173.301(a)(9) must then be overpacked in a DOT Specification 1A2 steel or 1H2 plastic drum tested and marked for a Packing Group II or higher performance level.

(iii) The Class 3, 4, 5 and 8 material must be packaged in labpacks as provided in § 173.12(b).

b. MARKING - For Division 2.3 materials, and Division 2.1 materials that require a DOT Specification 1A2 steel or 1H2 plastic drum as an overpack, each overpack must be marked "INSIDE PACKAGINGS COMPLY WITH PRESCRIBED SPECIFICATIONS."

c. Packages containing Division 2.3 materials must be separated within the transport vehicle from packages containing Division 2.1, Class 3, Class 4, Class 5, and

Class 8 materials by a five foot buffer zone which may contain packages containing hazardous materials authorized by § 177.848 to be transported on the same vehicle with the other hazardous materials. In addition, all steel or plastic overpacks containing packages of Division 2.1 or Division 2.3 material must be placed on pallets within the transport vehicle.

d. Packages must be secured against movement within the transport vehicle in accordance with § 177.834.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

a. A person who is not a holder of this exemption who receives a package covered by this exemption may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the package or its contents and it is reoffered for transportation in conformance with this exemption and the HMR.

b. A current copy of this exemption must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of the exemption (Appendix A may be shortened to include the first and last pages and the page on which the offeror's name appears) must be carried aboard each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this exemption.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:


- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Persons operating under the terms of this exemption must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8 who performs a function subject to this exemption must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this exemption in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use of apply this exemption, including display of its number, when the exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

12. **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:** The carrier is required to report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety (AAHMS) as soon as practicable. (Sections 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of this exemption.) In addition, the holder(s) of this exemption must inform the AAHMS, in writing, of any incidents involving the package and shipments made under the terms of this exemption.
