1. GRANTEE: Harris Corporation

2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:

- a. This exemption authorizes the transportation in commerce of certain hazardous materials across public roads between Harris Corporation facilities, not subject to the shipping paper requirements in the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR). This exemption provides no relief from the HMR other than as specifically stated herein.
- b. The safety analyses performed in development of this exemption only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce.

3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.

4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 172 Subpart C in that shipping papers are not required, and § 172.301(c) in that the marking requirements are waived.

5. BASIS: This exemption is based on the application of Harris Corporation dated October 11, 2002 and additional information dated February 26, 2003, submitted in accordance with § 107.105 and public proceedings thereon.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

- a. PACKAGING - Prescribed packagings are non-bulk packagings as required by the HMR.
- b. The packages may be transported only between Harris Corporation facilities by private or contract motor carrier.
- c. A "CHEMICAL CHECK OUT - PICK TICKET" that lists the part number, chemical name and quantity for each hazardous material must be carried on the motor vehicle.
- d. An Emergency Response Guidebook and an emergency response telephone number as required by Part 172, subpart G must be carried on the motor vehicle.
- e. No more than 1000 pounds gross weight of hazardous materials covered by this exemption may be transported at one time.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: A current copy of this exemption must be maintained at each facility where the packages are offered for transportation.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: None as a requirement of this exemption.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:

- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this exemption must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this exemption in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when this exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: The carrier is required to report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety (AAHMS) as soon as practicable. (Sections 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of this exemption.) In addition, the holder(s) of this exemption must inform the AAHMS, in writing, of any incident involving the package and shipments made under the terms of this exemption.


